1 Requirements to Obtain Two Teachable Subjects

For admission into the BEd for Intermediate/Senior teaching (grades 7-12), students need two teachable subjects:

- First Teachable requires 10 courses in that subject in the undergraduate degree
- Second teachable requires 10 courses in that subject in the undergraduate degree

Students aiming for prepare for Intermediate/Senior teaching (I/S) should work closely with an academic advisor to ensure they meet BA EDST requirements and requirements for entry into the I/S BEd program.

Electives

- **2 Open Elective**
 - A course from any faculty at any level
- **3 Educational Studies Elective**
 - Any EDST course that is not a core course

Depth Requirements

- In total, at least 12 courses are required at the 3000- and 4000-level.
- No more than 14 courses may be at the 1000 level.
